LESSON	MAIN POINT	BIBLE STORY	BIBLE VERSE	LESSON GOAL
Lesson 1	I Will Do What God Wants!	Gideon Does What God Wants (Judges 6-7)	Proverbs 3:5-6	The children will learn that they should follow God by doing what He wants. They can learn what God wants by praying, reading their Bible, coming to church, and listening to others.
Lesson 2	I Will Stand Up For What Is Right!	Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego (Daniel 3)	1 Corinthians 16:13	The children will learn that they should do what God says is right, despite potential rewards or consequences.
Lesson 3	I Will Make Wise Choices!	King Solomon (1 Kings 3)	Proverbs 2:11	The children will learn that God wants us to make wise choices, and they should ask God to help them do that.
Lesson 4	I Will Act With Kindness!	Abigail Shows Kindness to David (1 Samuel 25)	Ephesians 4:32	The children will learn that they should treat other people with kindness; they can do this with their words and their actions.
Lesson 5	I Will Learn From People In The Bible And From Others!	King Belshazzar and the Writing on the Wall (Daniel 5)	Proverbs 19:20	The children will learn that they should learn from the positive and negative examples of other people in the Bible, and people around them and should use this knowledge to make better choices.
Lesson 6	I Will Show My Faith Through My Actions!	Jesus and the Sick Woman (Matthew 9)	James 2:18b	The children will learn that they should act on their faith. There are a number of ways they can do this, including sharing faith with others and doing what you know God wants you to do.
Lesson 7	I Will Take A Risk To Help Others!	Esther Saves the Jews (Esther)	Luke 3:11b	The children will learn that we should help people in need, even if it means risking our comfort and safety.
Lesson 8	I Will Follow Jesus' Example!	The Salvation Story (passages from Matthew, Mark, Luke and John)	Philippians 2:5	The children will learn that Jesus took the punishment for our sins, and they will be given a chance to respond.
