LESSON	MAIN POINT	BIBLE STORY	BIBLE VERSE	LESSON GOAL
Lesson 1	Follow God's Plan!	Solomon Builds the Temples (1 Chronicles 28:1-9; 2 Chronicles 2-4)	Jeremiah 29:11	The children will learn that God has a plan for our lives. And by following God's plan, we can experience the best life possible.
Lesson 2	Obey God Above All Else!	Noah Builds the Ark (Genesis 6-10)	Matthew 6:33	The children will learn that God is the ultimate authority and we should be obedient to Him above all others.
Lesson 3	Never Give Up Doing Good!	Nehemiah Builds the Wall (Nehemiah 1-7)	2 Thessalonians 3:13	The children will learn that as followers of God we should try to do good things. And even when doing something good becomes difficult, we shouldn't give up.
Lesson 4	Praise God Instead Of Yourself!	The Tower of Babel (Genesis 11:1-9)	Proverbs 29:23	The children will learn that we should focus on God and the great things He has done instead of focusing on ourselves. God deserves the praise, not us.
Lesson 5	Keep God Your Priority!	The Man Who Built for More Grain Storage (Luke 12:13-31)	1 Corinthians 7:31	The children will learn that we should keep God our priority. It is okay to be busy and to have possessions, but none of the things we do or own should ever become more important to us than God.
Lesson 6	Share With Others!	Elisha and the Rich Woman from Shunem (2 Kings 4:8-17)	Acts 20:35b	The children will learn that we should share with others because everything we have comes from God. And God wants us to use what He has given us so we can help others.
Lesson 7	You Are The Church!	Jesus Builds the Church (Matthew 16:13-20)	Hebrews 10:25	The children will learn that the church is not just the building where we meet. The church is really the people who serve and worship God together.
Lesson 8	Keep On Serving God!	The Builder Who Did Not Finish (Luke 14:25-50)	Philippians 3:8a	The children will learn that when we make the decision to follow Jesus and serve God, we should know that it will not always be easy. However, it is the absolute best way to live life.
